

Rocket Division Software Releases Free iSCSI Target and Initiator Software for Microsoft Windows.

The free version of StarWind provides up to 2TB of storage capacity. An update release of the full version of StarWind and StarPort is also available which includes full support for VMware ESX. StarWind and StarPort support industry standard servers and various Microsoft Windows operating systems.

The full version of StarWind is also available as a SDK (software development kit) which is ideal for OEM customers that require a software-based iSCSI target for Microsoft Windows. The SDK provides a full featured iSCSI target API allowing easy customizations for vendors interested in implementing their own iSCSI storage.
